DEACON'S CORNER

August 2, 2024

Deacon Don provided some biographical information on St. Peter Julian Eymard (the saint of the day). He was a native of France who joined the Marist order in 1839. He founded a congregation of priest adorers of the Blessed Sacrament in 1856 and a women's community of lay apostolate thereafter. He

encouraged lay people to receive communion on a frequent basis. Deacon Don noted that only in the early 20th century was the age to receive first communion lowered from 15 years to 7 years and frequent communion was encouraged. Before then, communion was typically received at Christmas and Easter. Deacon Don then educated us through a short quiz regarding doctors of the Church where we learned there are 36 doctors in the Church, "the angelic doctor" is St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Ephraem the Syrian is the only doctor of the Church who was a permanent deacon, four women have been declared doctors of the Church: Sts. Catherine of Siena, Teresa of Avila, Therese of Lisieux and Hildegard of Bingen.

of Assisi Church in Castle Rock, CO. Keynote speaker will be Candace Tyrell, Serra U. S. Council Vice President of Membership. A hospitality event on Friday, October 25 will precede the convention (further details to come). Our speaker this day was our very own Chaplain, Deacon Don Schaefer. He spoke about the "silent prayers" said during the Mass. He referenced the Roman Missal that includes everything the priest and deacon (and laity) are to do and say during the Mass. His insights and discussion of these quiet moments that occur during the Mass were enlightening and a reminder that the Mass is an opportunity to have a personal intimacy with God in prayer.

Dominic Borchers

Our speaker this day was Dominic Borchers, a second-year seminarian at St. John Vianney Seminary. Mr. Borchers spoke of his faith journey and discernment process that brought him to his second year in

seminary preparing for priesthood. He was born in Ohio while his father was pursuing a theology degree from Franciscan University in Steubenville, OH. He was raised in a devout Catholic family and noted all his siblings are still profoundly Catholic. He lived six years in South Dakota until age seven. His next three years were in Chicago and his teen years in California. When he was 10 years old, his mother suffered a near fatal aneurism. Despite her survival and almost full recovery, he has come to realize that this event had a traumatic and significant effect on him. He has come to understand God used this trauma in his life as part of his formation into what he is now and that his relationship with God is better because of it. He attended Christendom College in Virginia and pursued a liberal arts degree majoring in theology and minoring in philosophy. He was particularly influenced by reading Christ in His Mysteries, by Columba Marmion regarding the hidden life of Christ (the undocumented 30 years from birth to the beginning of public ministry). Reflecting on development of the interior life, Mr. Borchers expressed these two options to living life: 1) either be really busy doing things for the Church, or preferably, 2) through prayer, reflection, and retreats allow God to help you undertake whatever work you do divinely. Two weeks after his college graduation, his father underwent spinal fusion surgery to address chronic back pain. The pain persists and causes Mr. Borchers to question the reason God allows this suffering, but helps him identify with others who are suffering. After dating, discerning, and driving 13,000 miles exploring the U.S., he eventually came to Denver, CO and felt a sense of "home". After moving to Denver, he attended his brother's wedding and the following weekend, attended a classmate's ordination. Reflecting on these two sacramental events helped him decide to enter seminary in Denver.
